John T. Rhodes Most Valuable Player Award - The Most Valuable Player award for the Myrtle Beach Invitational is named in honor of John T. Rhodes, known as the "Father of Sports Tourism" for the coastal resort city. After graduating from Carolina Military Academy in Maxton, N.C., Rhodes moved to Myrtle Beach, where he was a basketball and baseball player at Coastal Carolina University. After his CCU career, Rhodes worked in the lodging and restaurant industry in the Grand Strand, where he became a voting member of the McDonald's All-American Selection Committee. He helped conceive a Christmas high school basketball tournament in 1981 that would highlight local players. Rhodes was the Executive Director of the Beach Ball Classic and built the event into one of the nation's top Christmas high school basketball tournaments. He served 12 years as the mayor of Myrtle Beach, devoting time to countless committees to improve the lives of children while generating economic development and growth along the Grand Strand. Rhodes, who was awarded an honorary degree (Doctor of Public Service) from Coastal Carolina in December 2020, passed away in January 2021.
